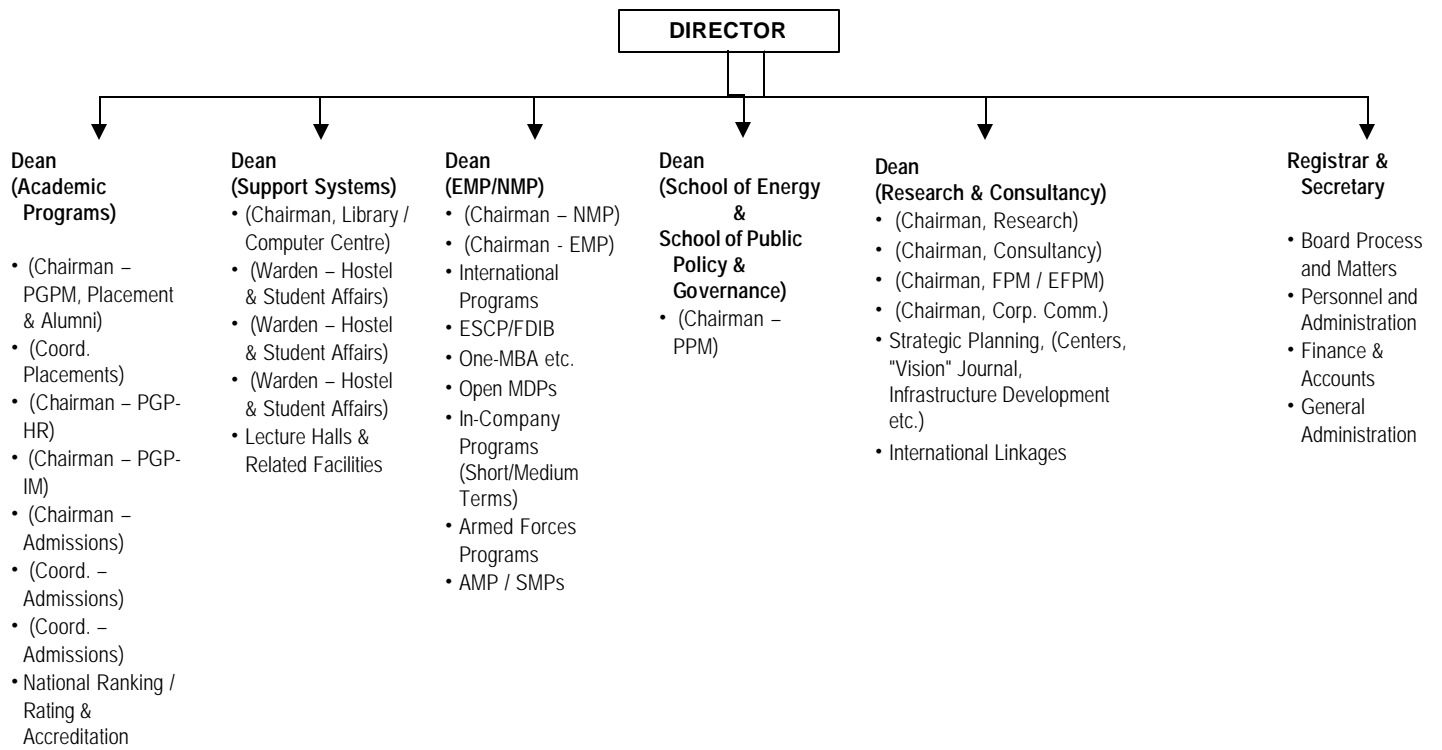
➤ **Academic Advisory Council:**

XI. CRITERIA AND WEIGHTAGES FOR ADMISSION

MDI uses CAT for short listing the candidates for its programmes. Short listed candidates are then required to appear for group discussions followed by personal interview.
