

Poonam Gyanchandani Memorial Merit Cum Means Scholarship for PGDM Students

07 (Seven) students of PGDM (2021-23) programme will be awarded Poonam Gyanchandani Memorial Scholarship @ Rs. 5.00 Lac each by RSPL Welfare fund on the basis of merit cum means.

The following will be the selection criteria for this Scholarship:

Please note that:

- The student will not be considered for award of Scholarship who is found indulging in any act of indiscipline/use of unfair means in the examination or whose conduct is found to be unsatisfactory.
- The student, who is repeating the programme/course, will not be eligible for the award of Scholarship.
- The Scholarship amount to the eligible students will automatically be credited directly in the account of the students/may be adjusted against the fee.
- The student will have to provide the income certificate duly countersigned by employer / Block Development Officer/Tehsildar, as the case may be, in support of the income proof and Income Tax Return of the last 03 years.
- Also, an undertaking on a non judicial stamp paper duly signed by a First class Magistrate, will have to be provided mentioning the total income of the family.
- **In case of submission of fake income certificates/documents by the student(s) for availing the Merit cum Means Scholarship, the severe disciplinary action will be taken against the students which may include the rustication from the Programme.**

Application process:

The applications will be invited from the eligible students after the result of Term-III is declared. All the eligible applicants, as per the criteria for merit and means as given above, will be called for an interaction with the Committee approved by the competent authority at a given date and timings. After due process and deliberations, the Scholarship Committee would make a recommendation for the award of "Merit-cum-Means Scholarship" which is to be approved by the Director.

Other Conditions:

- The scholarship scheme will not be available to any student who is already availing the benefit of any other scholarship from anywhere else.
- An undertaking in this regard will have to be submitted by the students at the time of filling the application for Scholarship. However, this will not be applicable in case of Merit Scholarship being awarded by MDI on the basis of academic performance to the students.
- If any disciplinary action is taken against the scholarship awardees then the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student concerned will have to return the amount within 15 days of the demand letter. Failing to return the amount of Scholarship, would result into further action as may deem fit and decided by the Committee.
