

## MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE GURGAON

The admission to MDI Gurgaon PGP Programmes is carried out in two stages.

**Stage 1: ( Short listing):** The short listing of candidates for WAT-GD-PI is done on the basis of CAT-2017 percentiles including sectional cut offs. The minimum CAT cut-off percentile is decided based on the number of candidates to be shortlisted. The number of candidates to be shortlisted is decided as per admissions policy of MDI Gurgaon.

**Stage 2: (WAT-GD-PI):** The shortlisted candidates go through the following process:

1. **Written Analysis Test (WAT):** Candidates have to submit a written analysis on the topic provided. The evaluation of WAT is done on two parameters (1) Analysis & Conceptual Clarity and (2) Grammar, Spelling & Presentation.
2. **Group Discussion (GD):** Candidates have to discuss on a particular topic in group discussion. The evaluation of GD is on two parameters: (1) Group Behavior (2) Content and Subject matter.
3. **Personal Interview:** Thereafter candidates have to appear for personal interview. The evaluation is done on three parameters: (1) Communication (2) Analytical Ability and (3) Personality Profile.
4. The weightage for the three components of selection are given below:

<b>CAT-2017</b>	Overall CAT-2017 score	55%
<b>Application Score</b>	X, XII, Academic Diversity, Gender Diversity and Work Experience	15%
<b>WAT-GD-PI</b>		30%

The merit list is prepared by considering CAT-2017 scores, Application score and WAT-GD-PI Score.

Other Important information related to PGP Admissions 2018.

1. The shortlisted candidates are asked to give their preferences for PGPM/PGP-HRM and PGP-IM by logging in at MDI Gurgaon website once the shortlist is out.
2. Candidates are not allowed to make any change in their preferences of programmes once made.
