Merit cum Means Scholarship Schemes available for Graduate Programmes students

Management Development Institute Gurgaon provides the following merit cum means scholarships to the students:

AICTE Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme (Scheme-I)

As per AICTE Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) scheme Upto a maximum of 15 students in the first year of PGDM Programme and 6 in the PGDM-HRM Programme over and above the approved intake are given scholarships of 100% tuition fee waiver on the basis of their merit in the admissions rank.

These students are selected out of the candidates who applied to us and whose family income is upto Rs. 8.00 Lacs per annum. The students are required to produce any of the following certificates issued during the year of application at the time of applying to the programme to be considered for the TFW Scheme:

- 1. Family income certificate issued by any Govt. revenue authority
- 2. Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Certificate
- 3. Non-Creamy Layer certificate issued by a Govt. body

Those who apply are considered on the basis of their admissions rank subject to maximum number of candidate, over and above the approved intake, as per the guidelines of AICTE.

A total no. of 20 TFW scheme scholarship were given where the amount of INR 3,52,00,000 (Rupees three crores fifty-two lacs) was waived off as the 100% tuition fee waiver to the above students.

Merit cum Means Scholarship (Scheme-II)

MDI provides a total number of 10 merit cum means scholarships (50% waiver of tuition fees) every year to the students pursuing two-year full time PGDM/PGDM-HRM/PGDM-IB at MDI Gurgaon.

1. Eligibility

The annual income of the parents of the applicant should not exceed Rs.8.0 lakhs.*

^{*} The income slab is linked with the applicable Govt. policy for EWS (Economically Weaker Section) wherein the benefits are extended to persons with family income below Rs.8.0 lakhs per annum.

2. Amount of Scholarship

a) An amount equivalent to 50% of the tuition fee of two years will be given in the entire duration of PGDM and the scholarship is linked with his/her performance in term examinations upto term-II and thereafter Term-III, IV and V.

The following amount of scholarship will be provided to 2021-23 students:

1. Disbursement of Scholarship

The fees to be paid by all the students including those qualifying for the scholarship as per the scheduled installments of fees. However, for the 10 students who qualify for

scholarship, the amount will be credited in their bank accounts after the recommendation of the Scholarship Selection Committee and approval by the Competent Authority.

The scholarship may be disbursed as per the details given in table below: -

2. Selection Procedure

- a) Since the students are settling down in the Term-I, the CGPA of Term I & Term II should be above 6.0, which will be considered for the scholarship for the eligible candidates.
- b) Parents income of the eligible candidates should not be more than Rs.8.0 lakhs* per annum based on bona fide documents submitted by the candidates to the GP office.
 - * As applicable as per Govt. policy for EWS (Economically Weaker Section).
- c) In case of a tie, the absolute score of the courses (Term-I & Term-II) of the particular students will be taken into the consideration.
- d) To continue getting the scholarship, the awardee is required to maintain at least 6.0 CGPA in each term. In case of poor performance, i.e. securing less than 6.0 CGPA in any term, there will be no scholarship in the subsequent term. However, once securing 6.0or more CGPA, the scholarship will be restored in the subsequent term.

3. Procedure for applying for the scholarship

Circular for the scholarship will be released at the time of admission on the website by GP office. All the students who are eligible may apply for the scholarship. Selection of awardeeswill be done after the announcement of result of Term-II by the Scholarship Selection Committee comprising of Dean (GP), Programme Chairpersons and two (2) Faculty members nominated by the Director.

4. Other terms & conditions

- a) The scholarship granted under this scheme is subject to good academic performance of minimum 6 CGPA and good behavioral conduct of the candidate as per student's handbook.
- b) The decision of the Institute in all matters like selection, continuation/ discontinuation of the scholarship will be final.
- c) The candidate drawing scholarship from any other sources will not be eligible for this scholarship which means no candidate should avail two or more scholarships at a time.
- d) The above scholarship scheme will be revised as and when required by the Institute.
