Any Institute (HEIs) willing to establish IIC and meet any one of following criteria can establish IIC at their Institute


- Having pre-incubation centres/incubation centers, student idea clubs.

Primarily, IICs' role is to engage large number of faculty, List of Institutes Established IIC various innovation and entrepreneurship related activities such as ideation, Problem solving, Proof of Conc.

Thinking, IPR, project handling and management at Pre-incubation/Incubation stage, etc., so that innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem gets established and stabilized in HEIs.
