

Government is sensitive towards the dignity of women: CM

Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has said that, in the ongoing social revolution for women empowerment in the history of the state, I am overwhelmed by the immense widespread support of the Ladli Bahnas to the government. With everyone's cooperation, we will create a new Atmanirbhar Madhya Pradesh, which will be in line with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of a glorious, strong and Atmanirbhar Bharat. After Ladli Lakshmi, Mukhya Mantri Kanya Vivah, Sambal Yojana, the Ladli Bahna Yojana will prove to be a milestone in this direction.

Chouhan was addressing a huge gathering at Ladli Bahna Mahasammelan at Shujalpur in Shajapur district <on

Wednesday. The Chief Minister dedicated development works worth Rs 118 crore 68 lakh and performed bhoomi puja and distributed benefits to the beneficiaries of various schemes. In the beginning, the Chief Minister performed Kanya Pujan and Kalash Pujan. Shajapur district administration's 'Shajapur Jandarshan' booklet was also released. Ladli Bahnas tied rakhi to their dear brother and applied tilak on his forehead. Ladli Bahna song was also sung in the programme.

The Chief Minister said that he has been observing discrimination between sons and daughters since childhood, the son whom the parents consider as a support of their old age, is unpredictable, but I guarantee that the daughters will not forget their parents till their last

breath. When I came into politics, I took a vow that I will make every daughter a boon and till today I am continuously in this direction.

Chouhan said that continuous work is being done for the empowerment of women in the state. The condition of daughters in Madhya Pradesh was not good, only 900 girls were born in proportion to 1000 boys. When I became the Chief Minister in the year 2005, I introduced the Ladli Laxmi Yojana. Under the scheme, the government gives a savings certificate of Rs. 30,000 to the poor families for up to two daughters. Apart from this, they get money from time to time for studies and a lump sum amount of Rs one lakh on attaining 21 years of age. Rs 12 thousand 500 is given to the daughters while taking admis-

sion in the college and Rs 12 thousand 500 on getting the degree. The government also pays the fees for their higher education.

Chouhan said that I have resolved that the government will get every poor girl married and for this the Mukhyamantri Kanya Vivah-Nikah Yojana was launched. In the Sambal Yojana also, women are given Rs. 4000 before delivery and Rs. 12000 post delivery. To empower the women politically, 50 percent reservation was given to them in Panchayat and urban bodies. 30 percent reservation is given to women in police recruitment and 50 percent reservation in teacher recruitment. They also have to pay only one percent amount in the stamp duty of the registry.

Chouhan said that Mukhya Mantri Ladli Bahna Yojana

will prove to be a milestone in making sisters empowered and self-dependent. Under the scheme, an amount of 1000 will be given to the sisters in their accounts from June 10. Families whose annual income is less than Rs 2.5 lakh, do not have more than 5 acres of land, do not have a four wheel vehicle and sisters between the age of 23 to 60 years will get the benefit of the scheme. The forms of the scheme are being filled up to April 30. Even after this, if any name is left out, then she will also be given the benefit. For this it is mandatory for every sister to have a bank account. Chouhan instructed the collector that free KYC should be done for every sister and other sisters who do not have bank accounts their accounts should be opened immediately.

PCC Chief Kamal Nath is CM candidate

Even before the assembly elections in MP Congress, a ruckus has started on the candidature. Till now the statements of the leaders about making Kamal Nath the face of the Chief Minister used to come to the fore, but now the contenders for the assembly elections are promoting themselves as candidates. There is no rule for himself and if the worker writes, action will be taken.

Academy players will get millet meal once a week: Miister

Sports and Youth Welfare Minister Yashodhara Raj Scindia has directed the officers to ensure that the players of all the sports academies run in the state get millet meal once a week. Scindia was reviewing the Water Sports Academy at TT Nagar Stadium in Bhopal on Tuesday.

Sports Minister Scindia said that we have taken this decision as per the intention of Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan.

She said that millet crops have been given the status of nutritional grain and providing nutrition-rich food to the players would be helpful in enhancing their game. The grains of these crops are rich in iron, calcium, fiber etc. It is worth mentioning that in sports academies of different disciplines run by the Sports and Youth Welfare Department in Madhya Pradesh, diet has been fixed

for the players according to their sports. Meals are provided to the players under the supervision of a nutritionist.

While reviewing the Water Sports Academy, Sports Minister Yashodhara Raj Scindia said that in the first phase for the academy, talent search should be conducted in about 25 districts between May 1 and 15.

On the basis of the districts from where more talented players will be selected through talent search, it will be considered to open feeder centres there. Minister Scindia said that IQ test, physical test etc. should also be conducted according to age category during the talent search.

He said that it is our responsibility to take talented children to the national level. Take help of senior players for training of new children. Director Sports and Youth Welfare Ravi Kumar Gupta, Instructor of Water Sports Academy was present.

India is mother of shree anna (millets): Patel

Farmers' Welfare and Agriculture Development Minister Kamal Patel has said that India is the mother of Shree Anna (millets). Today it is being produced in 131 countries of the world. Minister Patel was addressing the national seminar on 'Millets: Potential and Opportunity' being held in Mussoorie, Uttarakhand. He said that work is being done to convert despair into hope under the capable and successful leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

With his inspiration, the United Nations has declared the year 2023 as the International Year of Millet. The seminar was inaugurated by the Chief Minister of Uttarakhand, Pushkar Singh Dhami.

Agriculture Minister Patel said that the government of Devbhoomi Uttarakhand has

also made a significant contribution in realising Prime Minister Modi's dream of an Atma-nirbhar Bharat, by organising the national seminar on Shree Anna. Most of the income of the land of sages and seers has been dependent on agriculture. Even today India is an agricultural country. Farmers are the backbone of the economy, this backbone needs to be further strengthened.

Prime Minister Modi took care of the farmers and implemented various welfare schemes to make them self-reliant. Minister Patel welcomed and felicitated all those involved in the seminar on behalf of Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan and the farmers of the state.

Agriculture Minister Patel informed that State Millet Mission has been set up in Madhya Pradesh. Through this, 80 percent subsidy will be

Necessary arrangements will also be made for processing, packaging and marketing of the produced crop. He apprised that Shree Anna will be served as nutritious food once a week in Anganwadis of Madhya Pradesh. Minister Patel said that cow rearing is also being encouraged to promote natural farming in Madhya Pradesh. Along with this, a board has also been constituted.

Agriculture Minister Patel expressed the hope that Prime Minister Modi's initiative will bear fruits in the International Year of Millet and India's Shree Anna will dominate the whole world. He said that positive results will come from the seminar, which will not only benefit the whole country but also the world.

Bhopal-Jaipur flight from Thursday

The Bhopal-Jaipur flight connecting both these cities is starting to operate. This flight starting in the summer season will prove to be convenient for the tourists. Indigo has taken the slot for this flight from the airport authority. The schedule has also been released. According to travel agents, its booking has started. This flight will operate three days a week on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

Direct flight to Jaipur was first started by Alliance Air. This flight used to come from Raipur to Bhopal and leave for Jaipur. In return it used to come from Jaipur to Bhopal and go to Raipur. This flight was abruptly stopped in 2019.

Spice Jet also connected Bhopal to Jaipur but the company stopped the flight after some time. Passengers are happy with the commencement of Indigo flight but travel agents say that this flight is good for coming from Jaipur to Bhopal but the departure schedule is not passenger friendly. It would have been more convenient if the flight had left from Bhopal in the morning. Usually, travellers going to tourist places prefer to travel by morning train or flight.

Passengers want change in its schedule of Bhopal-Jaipur flight. They say that its timing should be changed. The flight will currently operate three days a week. Depending on the number of passengers, it can also be run on all seven days.

MDI Gurgaon is the Commonwealth Hub

New Delhi: Management Development Institute (MDI), Gurgaon a 50-year-old management school in the National Capital Region (NCR) of India, is ranked among the top B-schools in India.

The institute in partnership with the Commonwealth, organized a roundtable on Generally Accepted Performance Principles (GAPP). Commonwealth Secretary General Rt Patricia Scotland KC, Prof. Luis Franceschi, Commonwealth Assistant Secretary General, Rajnish Kumar, Chairman, of the Board of Governors, MDI, along with country representatives, MDI faculty, and several policy experts attended the session.

Prof. Prajapati presented on GAAP that envisions governments designing an effective Government Performance Management System (GPMS). It was an extension to 8th June 2022 when more than 200 top civil servants from across the Commonwealth adopted a sixteen-point GAPP. One of the important underlying principles discussed and agreed upon as Generally Accepted Performance Principles (GAPP) was that "the performance of a government organization lies in the eyes of the holder".

The roundtable further elaborated on the four causes of poor government performance

1. Fragmentation of institutional responsibility for performance management
2. Fragmented responsibility for implementation,
3. Selective coverage with a time lag in reporting and
4. Most performance management systems are conceptually

flawed.

These causes are typically a universal problem with most governments across the World. Therefore, it's important to collaborate and envision, plan, and executes them with the exchange of experience and evidence across India.

With the objective of supporting the global governance agenda of Commonwealth governments to do their business more effectively, efficiently, and equitably the MDI School of Public Policy and Governance plans to set up a hub for stimulating capacity building, and research on the effective delivery of public services and efficient implementation of public policies that affects society, business and the government for inclusive and sustainable development.
